Ken McIndoe

Hopewell resident Ken McIndoe, a landscape painter and professor of landscape painting at the Art Students League in New York City, will be the featured speaker in the Hopewell Public Library's Wednesday Night Out Series, October 12, 7 p.m., at the Hopewell Train Station, Railroad Place, Hopewell.

Born in London, McIndoe lived in Africa before coming to the United States. McIndoe has been teaching landscape painting at the Art Students League in New York City since 1981. He taught painting in Ireland, South Korea, and Alaska. He has received New Jersey State Council on the Arts Fellowships in 1987 and 2000.

"I began to work outside in the urban and rural landscape," McIndoe explained. "Those experiences continue to be a great source of discovery. I think the student should work both from nature and from imagination -- from the outside and the inside. You have to be guided by your knowledge and intuition, and aspire to a vision of a world that has no intention of waiting for you."
