

Library Closure Update

March 21, 2020

The Hopewell Public Library is closed until further notice.

All due dates will be extended until we reopen. You will continue to get our regularly scheduled notices about due dates, but you will have one week after we reopen to return any items you have outstanding. All fines have been waived since our closing date of March 16.

If you had an item on hold prior to our closing, you may retrieve it up to one week after we reopen; however, we will not honor any new holds that come in during our closure. We will not be accepting or processing Inter Library Loans (ILL) until we reopen. All Inter Library Loans have been suspended around the State. Returns of outstanding ILLs will be accepted for one week after we reopen.

If you get a notice that your card is about to expire during the closed period, we will not suspend your account. We will honor your card for one week after we reopen. HPL will continue to post updates on this website and we invite you follow us on Facebook and Instagram. We will post news, reading suggestions, stories to read aloud to children, cooking ideas and even how to take a walk around Hopewell to discover the wonders of the your borough.
